The Welfare fund is excited to announce the opening of the **IUOE Local 542 Health Center.** We've partnered with ACTIVATE, the union division of Everside to run the Health Center.

The Health center is the same as a family practice or your standard doctor's office, *except* **all services are free** including prescriptions dispensed during your appointment at the Health Center.

The Health Center is available to eligible members and their dependents (over 2 years old). Please note: we are not able to treat Medicare patients at this time.

All visits need to be scheduled in advance. Currently we are not accepting walk-in appointments. Virtual visits are also available; you will need an email account for virtual visits.

Do you have a prescription for blood work? The Health Center can draw your blood and send it to the lab for you. No Co-Pays; saves you and the Welfare Fund money!
